Dear Parents

Welcome all families back to BASC. Thank you all for your patience during this time. I would like to thank all my staff for their dedication and resilience at this time.

In order to keep all safe these procedures have been put in place to protect children families and staff.

Following health guidelines we will continue to restrict parents onsite, please do not enter the BASC building - please see signage.

Whilst the centre may be safe for children, it is adults that are the main spreaders of the virus.

- One family at a time entering through the gate to sign on. Please follow social distancing while waiting to enter the service
- Arrive early to avoid stress around waiting times to the Centre.
- Sanitise your children's hands upon arrival.
- Endeavour to make the drop off quick and calm
- Hygiene and cleaning requirements are being addressed to protect all children following our COVID-19 policy and cleaning plan to address the frequency of surfaces being cleaned.
- Soap dispensers and hand sanitisers are available throughout the Centre
- Children will sanitise hands upon departure to the school and arrival from school.
- Children will wash hands accordingly before eating and sharing of food will not be permitted
- If your child is unwell and has cold or flu symptoms e.g. runny nose or cough, please DO NOT send them. Any child who presents these symptoms will be sent home.
- Children are required to have breakfast before arrival and provide their own afternoon tea until Term 3. Can you please clearly mark your child's afternoon tea. If your child attends in the morning and afternoon, there will be baskets provided for you to place their afternoon tea in when you drop them off in the morning.
