BASC continues to take measures to protect the children, staff and parents of the centre. Thank you for adhering to the rules of waiting outside the gate to drop off and collect your child.

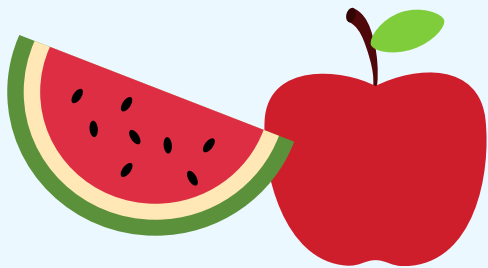
Please remember to ask your children to sanitise their hands upon arrival and departure from BASC. This will reduce the chances of cross infection between BASC and home.
